### **Press Release-September 14, 2016**

On September 14, 2016, at approximately 0905 hours, the Westtown-East Goshen Regional Police Department was dispatched to the report of a 2 vehicle crash in the 1000 block of Wilmington Pike, Westtown Township.

Upon arrival at the scene, officers determined that prior to the crash the vehicles (a 2013 Ford Fusion and a 2016 Kawasaki Ninja motorcycle) were traveling southbound on Route 202. For an undetermined reason the front bumper of the car struck the motorcycle, causing the motorcycle operator to be thrown from the motorcycle. The motorcyclist landed on the center median.

Both operators were transported by ambulance to Paoli Hospital. The motorcyclist (M/31, resident of Penn Valley, PA) is currently listed in critical condition. The vehicle operator (M/25, resident of Trenton, NJ) is listed in stable condition.

### **UPDATED INFORMATION-September 15, 2016**

The driver of the 2016 Kawasaki Ninja motorcycle, Dorian A. Dumas, Jr. (age 31) of Penn Valley, PA died as a result of injuries sustained in the accident on September 14, 2016.

The driver of the 2013 Ford Fusion, Jalmeel Conway (age 25) of Trenton, New Jersey has been released from Paoli Hospital and is cooperating with police.

This remains an active investigation and no additional information can be released at this time.
