**PRESS RELEASE**

On August 16, 2017 the Westtown-East Goshen Regional Police Department charged a former employee of a Downingtown based home health care service with theft in connection with jewelry stolen from residences in East Goshen Township and also Uwchlan Township.

A warrant of arrest was issued for Simranjeet Kaur, age 20, of the 1700 block of Norwood House Road, Downingtown, PA for two counts of theft by unlawful taking or disposition and two counts of receiving stolen property.

On July 12, 2017 a family member of a resident living in Wellington Hall on Boot Road in East Goshen Township called to report the theft of more than \$3,500.00 dollars in jewelry and \$70.00 dollars in cash from the residence. The only person that had access to this area was the home health care assistant.

During this investigation police determined that a similar theft report was filed with the Uwchlan Township Police Department on June 21, 2017 and that more than \$11,000.00 dollars in jewelry was taken and that the prime suspect was the same home health care assistant. The victim in Uwchlan Township lives in the 800 block of Robert Dean Drive.

The Westtown-East Goshen Regional Police Department and Uwchlan Township Police Department worked on this investigation together and then charges for both incidents were filed. The home health care company cooperated with police and provided assistance during the investigation.

Detectives were unable to locate Kaur to serve the arrest warrant and on August 19, 2017 the Caln Township Police Department stopped a vehicle that contained Simranjeet Kaur and she was taken into custody and arraigned before Magisterial District Judge Massey who set bail at \$10,000.00 dollars unsecured. A preliminary hearing is scheduled for this case on August 23, 2017 at 9:00 AM before Magisterial District Judge Tartaglio at District Court 15-1-02.
